SPRING CLEAN-UP - SATURDAY, April 15, 2023

The City of Shawnee will host a Spring Clean-Up Day on Saturday, April 15, 2023, for its residential utility (water and sanitation) customers from 8 am to 2 pm.

All locations will be staffed to assist customers and ensure that no unacceptable items are dumped in the rolloffs. This is a City of Shawnee event for residential utility customers only. Please bring your most recent utility bill. *Hazardous waste will be accepted during this event*.*

Locations of Roll-Offs

Transfer Station – 700 East 45th Street. Please enter the Transfer Station from the east and exit to the west.

Requirements

- An active City of Shawnee residential utility account is required. Bring with you a current residential utility statement and a driver's license, or other form of ID of the account holder.
- There is a maximum limit of 3 cubic yards, which is roughly equivalent to one level pickup truck bed. Trailer loads are not permitted. Please note that a load over 3 cubic yards will be turned away.
- If the load is more than 3 cubic yards, the load may be taken to the Transfer Station for a fee. Please check the City's <u>Solid Waste/Recycling</u> webpage for current rates.

*Household hazardous waste collected at events includes:

Household hazardous waste materials NOT accepted:

- Ammunition

In the event that the maximum capacity is reached prior to 2 pm, or if you are unable to participate in the Spring Clean-up Day, please note that City of Shawnee utility customers have curbside bulk waste pickup (up to 3 cubic yards) available the first full week of the month on their regular trash day. Construction and hazardous materials are not permitted during bulk waste pickup.

City of Shawnee utility customers may also use the Transfer Station once per month.

- Transfer Station is located on 45th Street between Union Avenue and Harrison Street.
- Customers must bring the current month's water bill and picture identification matching the name on the bill.
- The quantity is limited to a level pickup truck bed load (3 cubic yards).
- Only household items are accepted, no construction or hazardous waste.
